Note: Some of these are not corrections per se, but additional information to make the directions easier to understand for beginner quilters. All of these corrections will be in the final version of the pattern before printing.

Cutting Guide: Replacements for Azul Month 4 and Month 8 are attached.

Month 01 - At the beginning of the cutting directions, I added this note:

Note: Azul Fabric #3: Cut pieces in this order: B8, A2

Azul Fabric #8: Cut pieces in this order: A9, B9, A6

Step 5 on page 10 - Change the first sentence to: Repeat steps 10 thru 22 from **Block 1A**.

Month 02 - Step 5 and Step 6 - Note: the diagrams are on the bottom of page 4.

Step 18 - The diagram should be marked B6 & B7.

The correct Paper Pieces Patterns for Month 2 attached.

Month 03 - no changes

Month 04 - Step 6 on page 5 should read: Sew an A3 to the bottom of the block with the A5 center. Press toward A3. Make 4.

Step 16 on page 7: On row 2, press away from the center.

Month 05 - no changes

Month 06 - no changes

Month 07 - Cutting Directions:

To make sewing easier, change all the 4-1/2" squares to 4-3/4" squares in both the traditional and paper piecing cuts.

Also, in the cutting directions, In Paper Piecing: A12 should be A11

Month 08 - Fabric Requirements:

Azul: Fabric #9 51806-3 Should be: 18" x WOF

Cutting Instructions:

A9 Change: Cut (2) 2-1/8" wide strips to Cut (2) 2-1/4" wide strips.

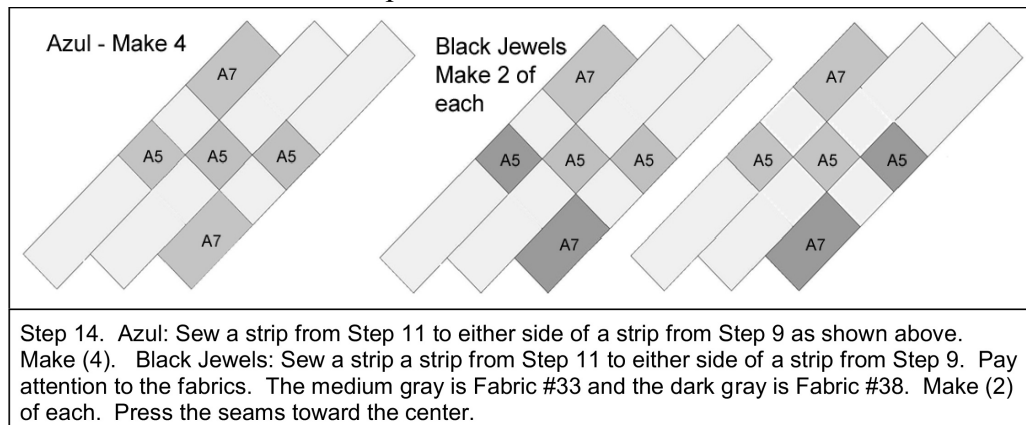
A1 & A3: Cut A1 first.

Step 37. Deleted the word "again".

Month 09 - Cutting Directions:

C1 Cut (10) 4-1/4" strips x WOF and Cut (1) 1-7/8" strip x WOF.

Additional instruction for Step 14:



Step 17. Change first sentence to: Place a ruler on top of the block from Step 16.

Step 21. Change first sentence to: Position the block so the A1 diamond is on the left side.

Add Step 27, I highly recommend stay stitching 1/8" from the edge around every sashing block after it is trimmed. After trimming the edges are 100% bias and without stay stitching the blocks will likely stretch and warp by the time they are assembled next month.

Month 10: Step 4: Added after third sentence: This is tricky, so use extra pins and baste this area together first.

Month 11: Additional information:

Step 9 & 10: The pictures for these directions are on the bottom of page 4.

Step 10: The bottoms will be trimmed off in Steps 11 thru 14.

Step 11: unfinished size is 2-1/4" x 4-1/2"

Step 12: unfinished size is 2" x 4-1/2"

Step 13: unfinished size is 1-3/4" x 4-1/2"

Step 14: unfinished size is 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Step 18: 4th item: 26 1/2" should be 26-1/2"

Month 12: Cutting directions:

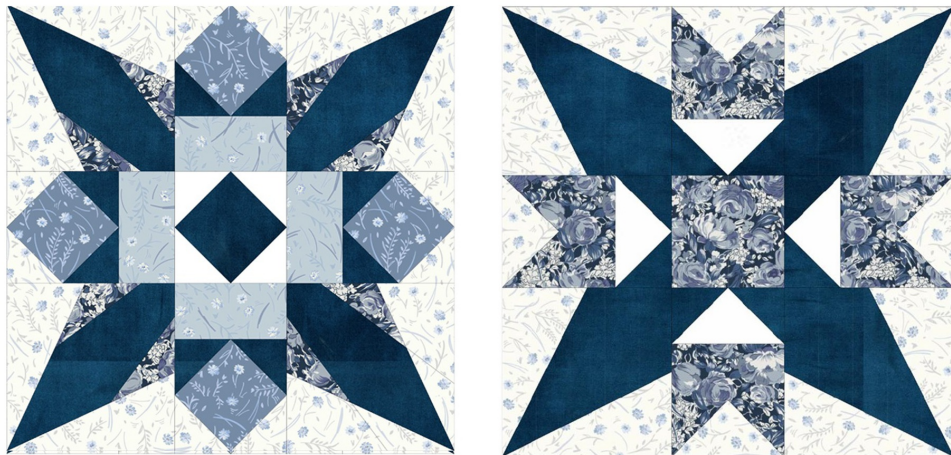
